WHEREAS, the city of Pateros has, by Ordinance No. 466, enacted May 17, 1988, ordained that all administrative fees shall be set by Resolution of the city council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of the city of Pateros that the following fees and charges shall henceforth be assessed:

Each subsequent request for water disconnects or reconnect shall cost $\$ 35.00$ for each service call during normal business hours.
For non-emergency connects or disconnects not scheduled during normal business hours, the cost shall be $\$ 100.00$ for each occurrence. (PMC 13.04.300) For charges for service outside regular hours; deemed the customers deficiency of improper operation or maintenance of plumbing a fee will charged (PMC 13.04.440) $\$ 50.00$.

In the case the test discloses an error of more than $3 \%$ in favor of the city; the deposit shall be refunded to the customer. Clerk will refer to PMC 13.04.380 (b) for billing adjustment.

## Multiple Businesses

When more than one commercial business shares a water meter/building, each entity shall be assessed the minimum charge of $\$ 65.63$ and overages at the commercial user's rate.

The City charges $\mathbf{\$ 4 . 0 0}$ (increase of $\mathbf{2 . 0 0}$ ) per service per month which is included in the costs listed below.
