

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-33

WHEREAS, the city of Pateros has, by Ordinance No. 466, enacted May 17, 1988, ordained that all administrative fees shall be set by Resolution of the city council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of the city of Pateros that the following fees and charges shall henceforth be assessed:

SECTION 1. ANIMAL LICENSES AND FEES:

Annual Fees

1. Dog or other animal requiring licenses.
Late charges assessed after April 30, 2017

Neutered	\$15.00
Unaltered	\$35.00
Replacement tag	\$ 2.00
Late fee (in addition to license fee)	\$15.00
Excess Animal (3 rd dog plus license)	\$60.00

2. Other animal control fees shall be:

Administration fee	\$30.00
Daily boarding fee	\$30.00 per day
• Second offense	\$50.00 per day
• Third offense	\$100 per day
Euthanasia and disposal	\$35.00
Registration of dangerous dog	\$75.00

SECTION 2. WATER RATES:

Rates for water service may be adjusted annually in accordance with Ordinance No. 598 dated November 15, 2000.

Fee for Water Connection

Each new water service established shall pay the actual costs of city labor and materials, including inspections, to establish the connection, plus a fee for capital improvements to the water system. The capital improvement fee shall be based on the water meter size as follows:

3/4 inch	\$ 1074.75
1 inch	\$ 1433.13
1.5 inch	\$ 2150.94
2 inch	\$ 3226.44
Over two inch will be decided on a case by case basis.	

Fee for Reconnect

\$1074.75

Where the property was connected to the water or sewer system in the past, but has not been connected for the past twelve months and has not paid a monthly billing or inactive fee a reconnect fee must be paid. Per Ordinance 04-631

Delinquent Water Bills

Late Fee	\$15.00
Shutoff & Reconnect Fee	\$50.00

If a delinquent water account remains off over one monthly period, an additional six percent interest for each month will be due and payable plus a reconnect fee of \$50.00 prior to water service being resumed.

Disconnect

The city shall provide one free disconnect to each water service annually. Each subsequent request for water disconnects or reconnect shall cost \$10.00 for each service call. For non-emergency connects or disconnects not scheduled forty-eight (48) hours in advance, the cost shall be \$100.00.

Outside City Limit Rate

First dwelling unit-eight thousand gallons (8,000)	\$66.33
Additional units, first eight thousand gallons (8,000)	\$66.33
Each additional one thousand gallons (1,000)	.68

All Motels, Hotels and RV Parks

First unit, room, or site eight thousand gallons (8,000)	\$ 75.23
Each additional unit, room or site	\$.86
Each additional one thousand gallons (1,000)	\$.86

Commercial Water Rate

First eight thousand gallons (8,000)	\$52.49
Each additional one thousand gallons	.67

Industrial Water Rate

First eight thousand gallons (8,000)	\$52.49
Each additional one thousand gallons	.67

Multiple Uses

Where more than one family dwelling, firm, business, association, or corporation uses water from the same meter, the water service shall be the same as if each family dwelling, firm, business, association, or corporation were separately connected and will be charged the minimum charge each month, for each additional user, plus the excess charge.

Each additional thousand gallons	\$ 20.62

Cemetery Water Rate

Billed for 6 months annually	Flat rate per month	\$188.18
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Inactive Water Rate

\$ 25.21

Stand-by rate is established for those residences that have their water service terminated for 45 days or more, but not for more than one year from the date of disconnect. (Resolution 2001-10 dtd.10/08/01)

SECTION 3 – SEWER RATES

Rates for sewer service may be adjusted annually in accordance with Ordinance No. 598 dated November 15, 2000.

Fee for Sewer Service Connection

The Capital improvement fee shall be based on the size of the water meter. Each new sewer service established shall pay the actual costs of city labor and materials, including inspection, to establish the connection, plus a fee for capital improvements to the sewer system. The capital improvements fee shall be based on the number of units as follows:

First unit	\$1183.90
Two through four units	\$990.74
Five through eight units	\$981.26
Nine through twelve units	\$800.07
Thirteen or more units	\$753.96

Sewer User Charges

Minimum monthly charge	\$47.33
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The minimum monthly charge will be assessed for all single family dwelling units, churches, and grange halls. For apartments, duplexes, and mobile home courts, each unit or space shall be assessed the minimum monthly charge.

Sewer User Charge - Commercial

Each business shall pay the minimum monthly charge of \$47.33 for the first four thousand gallons, plus \$.95 per thousand (\$3.80 for 4,000 gallons), for each 1,000 gallon increments of water used in excess of the 4,000 gallons.

Inactive Sewer Rate

\$25.21

Stand-by rate is established for those residences that have their sewer service terminated for 45 days or more, but not for more than one year from the date of disconnect. (Resolution 2001-10 dtd.10/08/01)

Multiple Businesses

When more than one commercial business shares a water meter/building, each entity shall be assessed the minimum charge of \$47.33 and overages at the commercial user’s rate.

Senior Citizen/Disabled Charges

To qualify:

1. You are at least 62 years of age or permanently disabled.
2. You own and occupy a residence in the city of Pateros.
3. The combined disposable income of the house is \$35,000 or less.

SECTION 4. GARBAGE COLLECTION RATES

In accordance with an agreement dated October 20, 1997; amended October 20, 2008) between the city of Pateros (City) and Zippy Disposal Service, Inc. (Contractor), Section 7.2 of said agreement states that the Contractor shall be entitled to increase the service charge in May or each year of this agreement, commencing in May 1999. Any such increase in the charge for Contractor’s service shall be based on the prior year’s change in the Consumer Price Index All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) US City Average using the December Index for each year. The City charges \$2.00 per service per month which is included in the costs listed below.

SECTION 10. TENNIS COURT

SECTION 11. SERVICES OUTSIDE OF CITY LIMITS

All city services provided outside the city limits, including sewer, water, garbage, labor and/or equipment shall be charged at thirty percent (30.0%) over the equivalent rate for city residents. Overage charges for outside users will be assessed at five cents per hundred (\$0.05/100 gallons). Rates will become effective on January 1, 2015. This Resolution No. 2014-20 is approved and adopted this 17th day of November, 2014.
